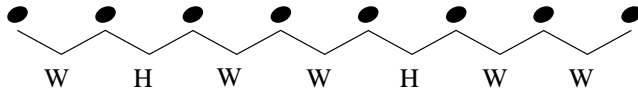

Then write the name of the scale and fill in its key signature.

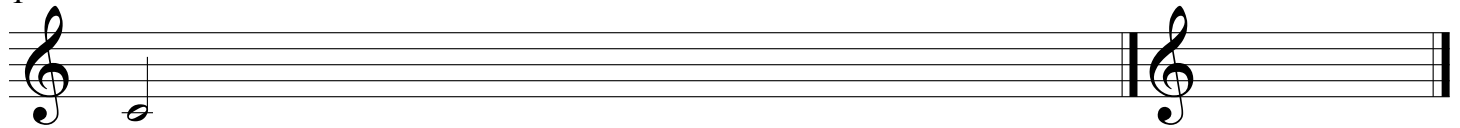
