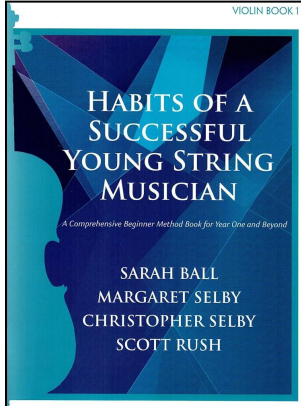


Beginning and Intermediate Orchestra Class Supply List

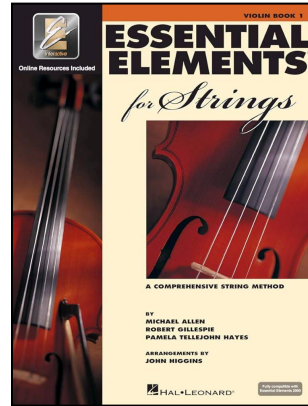
Please be sure to have all supplies by the first day of class.

Beginning Book: *Habits of a Successful Young String Musician* - Book 1 for violin, viola, or cello. (Make sure you get a book to match your instrument!)



Approximate cost: \$10-15, available at many music stores and online.

Advanced Book: *Essential Elements for Strings* - Book 1 for violin, viola, or cello. (Make sure you get a book to match your instrument!)



Approximate cost: \$12-17, available at most music stores and online.

Below is the list of additional supplies for your specific instrument:

1. **Shoulder Rest** matching the instrument size (Violins and Violas only)
Recommended: [Everest](#), [Kun](#), Firm Sponge ([Loft Violins](#)), or [Sure Tone](#)
Optional: [Shoulder Rest Bag](#) for cases which do not fit a shoulder rest
2. **Rock Stop or Anchor** ([Cellos](#) and Basses only) | Recommended: [Xeros endpin anchor](#)
3. **Clip-On Tuner** | Recommended: [D'Addario Micro](#), [D'Addario Eclipse](#), [Snark SN5X](#)
4. **Rosin** for the bow to make a sound on the strings | Recommended: [light/amber rosin](#)
5. **Fingerboard Markers** or finger tape. Ask if the music store will apply finger tape for you.
OR Recommended: Don't Fret for [violin](#), [viola](#), [cello](#) (Be sure to get the correct size!)
6. **Soft cloth** to keep the instrument clean
Recommended: hand-sized piece of an old cotton shirt, or [microfiber cloth like this](#))
7. **Sturdy, adjustable music stand** for home practice (portable, foldable options are also available)
8. **Extra set of strings** - at least D'Addario Prelude or higher quality. (Cellos: only an extra A string; Basses: no extra strings)
